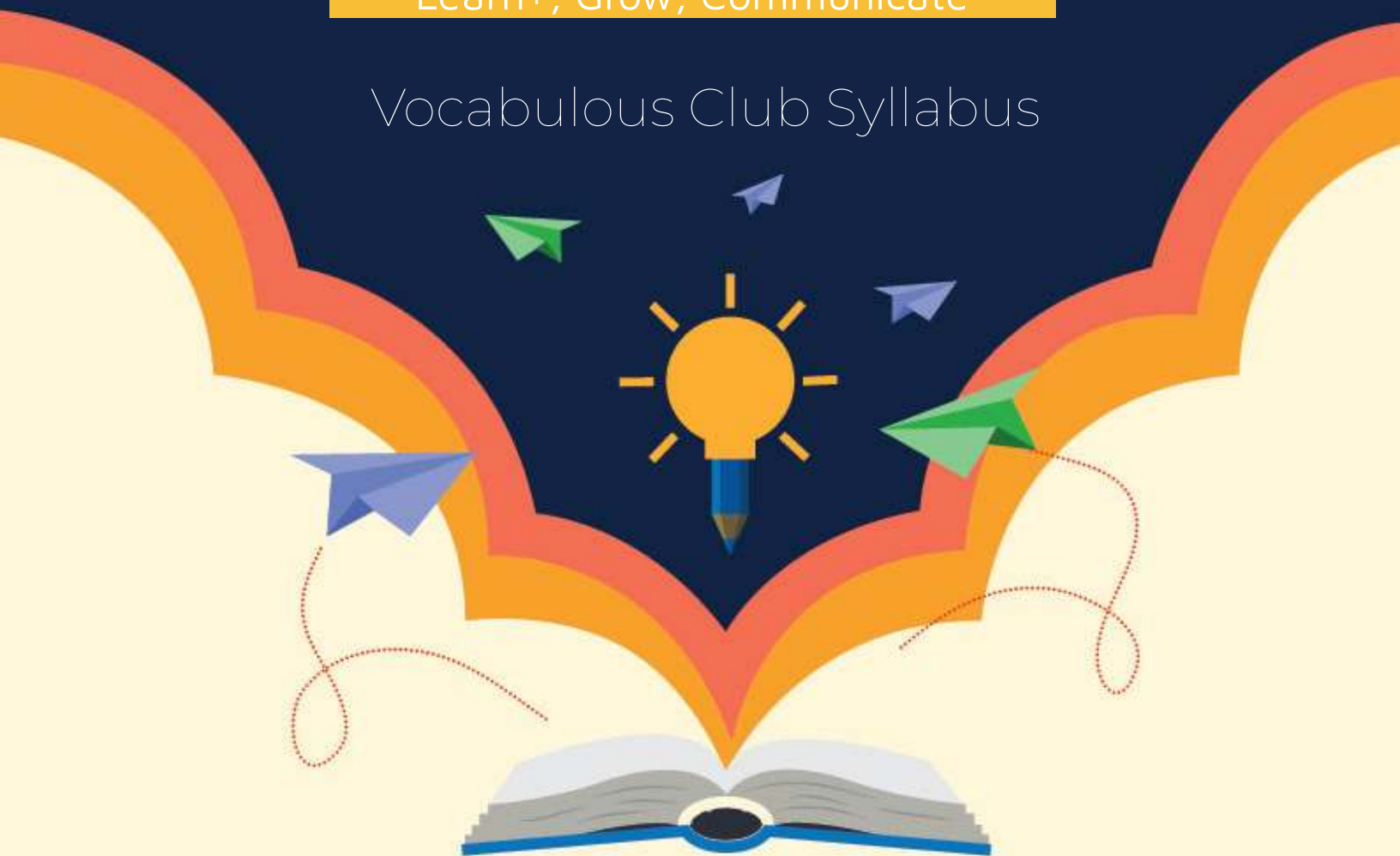

Vocabulous Club

Are you finding it hard to learn and remember new words? Well, why don't you join our new vocabulary club? Learn and practise new vocabulary as well as listening, reading and speaking in everyday and interesting contexts to feel a little more confident.

Level A

A day out: Talk about activities they might do on a free day.

Describing food : Learn useful vocabulary for describing different types of food, including terms for different flavours and dishes.

Television : Learn key vocabulary for talking about television.

Parts of the body : Learn useful vocabulary for describing parts of the body and functions of body parts.

Booking a holiday: Learn and use vocabulary for booking a holiday on the internet.

In the picture : Learn how to describe pictures within the context of sports.

Our holiday : Define vocabulary relating to holiday activities.

Flying: Learn useful vocabulary and situational expressions for catching a flight and describing an airport.

It's like this: Define vocabulary related to shades of colour and pattern. Listen to an animal rescue organization and learn the difference between questions with like, look like, be like and would like.

At the cinema: Learn basic cinema vocabulary.

A city break: Learn and practise vocabulary to talk about a city break.

Transport: Learn vocabulary related to public transport as well as practical expressions to use in a train station, in a taxi and at an airport check in desk.

Level B

At the hotel: learn how to book a room, check in and out of a hotel.

Making plans: learn vocabulary and expressions for making plans and arrangements.

Suggesting ideas: Learn vocabulary for describing and discussing ideas.

Attending a job interview: Learn useful vocabulary for attending a job interview in English.

At the clothes shop : Common words and expressions for describing clothes, clothing material and shopping for clothes.

Refunds and exchanges: Learn and practise vocabulary for returning purchases.

Art words: Learn vocabulary connected with art.

Sustainable Fashion: Read about the environmental impact of our current fashion culture and propose solutions to the problems.

Pet benefits: Read an article about the health benefits of keeping a pet and learn vocabulary for talking about health and well-being as well as functional expressions for connecting ideas and developing an argument.

Magic Mirror: "Augmented reality" learn more about this new technology and vocabulary related to this. "India's smog reaches dangerous levels" : learn vocabulary about pollution.

War and Conflict: learn vocabulary related to war, conflict and terrorism-

Elvis Presley: Learn some useful phrasal verbs with more than one meaning.

LEVEL C

Wildlife: students will expand their vocabulary for describing animals and their habitats. The lesson rounds off with an exercise on idioms related to animals and a discussion activity. A must for animal lovers.

Crime and punishment : Learn and practise vocabulary related to crime and punishment.

Getting served: read and learn vocabulary about a bartender's tips for getting served.

Elections and voting: Learn key vocabulary for describing the electoral system ,including people involved in political campaign's as well as collocations with the word "election".

Isolation: An article on the link between well-being and face-to-face interaction in the modern world.

Mind your thoughts: Key vocabulary about how computers will soon be able to read our minds and delete our thoughts!

Dimensions: Practise using words to describe the dimensionsof objects. Adjectives, verbs and nouns, synonyms and phrases with dimensional words.

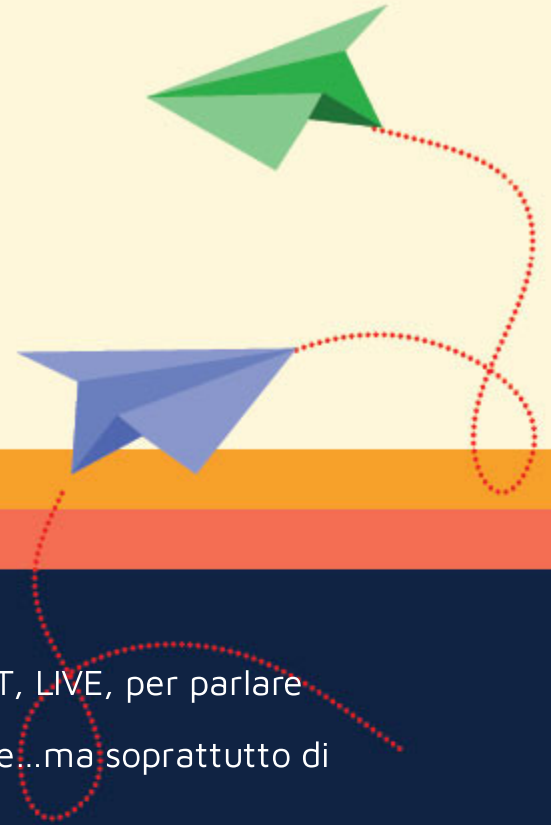
Smog : China's air pollution problems. Vocabulary related to air pollution.

Misdirection: Watch a talk by Apollo Robbins, the world's greatest pick-pocket. The lesson includes vocabulary and discussion activities.

Evolution: Watch scientist Prosanta Chakrabarty talk about how we need to question what we have been taught about evolution. Focus on vocabulary , comprehension and speaking.

Scam-baiting : Watch a hilarious talk. The speaker recounts what happened when he replied to a spam email in his inbox. Focus on discussion and vocabulary work.

Music: Learn and practise vocabulary related to music, including English words for musical instruments, adjectives and expressions for describing music as well as common idioms related to music.
